ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

Korean School of Fort Collins (KSFC) provides opportunities of learning and experiencing with Korean language, history, and culture for Northern Colorado community. Founded in 2001 and registered as a non-profit organization since Fall 2013, KSFC has been actively operated by dedicated faculty, staff, and board members. Current curriculum offers Korean language and calligraphy classes for students of various ages and fluency. Each class has its own objectives, textbooks, contents, and evaluation methods. Beside the academic activities, KSFC celebrates Korean traditional holidays and hosts various cultural and social events in collaboration with the Colorado Association for Korean Schools (COAKS). ACADEMIC OPERATION

KSFC follows the Academic Calendar of Poudre School District in Fort Collins, CO. Fall semester begins around late August or early September, while Spring semester starts around mid- January. Each semester usually consists of 12–16 weekend instructions. All the tuitions are to be 100% refunded until the second week of each term.

Korean Language Classes

The language classes include Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced for youth and adults, respectively. Each class holds 3–hour instructions from 9:00 a.m. to noon every Saturday. A person whose age is at least 4 by the time each term begins can apply for admission.

Korean Calligraphy Class



The calligraphy class holds 3 hour instructions from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. every Saturday. A person whose age is at least 10 by the time each term begins can apply for admission.

ACTIVITIES



KSFC celebrates Korean Traditional New Year's Day and Thanksgiving Day, and actively participates in community activities- "My Dream" Speech Competition, Writing/ Drawing Competition, Korean Traditional Folk Festival, and Teacher's Workshops - hosted by COAKS.

HISTORY

. 2001: KSFC was founded by Professor Joon Kim of Ethnic Studies Department at Colorado State University (CSU). Until 2003, KSFC met at Aylesworth Hall, CSU.

. 2004: KSFC changed the location to First Korean Church of Fort Collins with a verbal agreement to use the facility free of charge to serve Korean community activities.

. 2007: KSFC applied for educational support from Korean Education Center in San Francisco and began receiving annual financial support.

. 2007: KSFC became a member of the Colorado Association for Korean Schools in the fall.

. 2013: KSFC was declared as a non-profit organization on July 1st. The Board of Directors was assembled in November.

. 2014: KSFC was approved as a non-profit organization by Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code on September 18th.
